1.1 It was a great pleasure to see such a strong participation in the virtual video conference meeting. Dr. Sarangi expressed his desire to have more frequent meetings using the VC platform. Dr. Bhandari also expressed his happiness to see the leadership of ICC in young hands and volunteered his support and good wishes to the new committee. Professor R. Singh extended his good wishes. Dr. Sarkar commented that the ICC is the best professional society on the subject of cryogenics.

- 1.2 Professor Atrey welcomed the new committee and confirmed the organization of the new committee along with the following two changes in the West Zone: (EC member list attached)
 - a. As Professor Atrey is now the President of ICC, his post of Vice President and Chairman West Zone is now to be taken up by Professor H.B.Naik as per the elections held in September 2019.
 - b. Likewise Professor H.B. Naik's vacant position from being a member from West Zone, has been taken up by Professor H.J.Bahirat, who is also the Secretary of West Zone.

2.0 Deliberations

Different items were then taken up before the committee members as per the agenda, which are summed up below:

2.1 The members unanimously confirmed the minutes of the previous EC meeting held on June 20, 2019, at IUAC, New Delhi. The new committee lauded the work done by the earlier EC, especially in the organization of ICEC and NSCS-27.

2.2 **Tax Exemption Matter:** After due diligence and discussions on the matter of the Tax exemption certificate for ICC, it was unanimously decided that the Tax for the backlog may be paid and then the application can be made for tax exemption. As the last date for filing ITR is 30th November 2020, all zones are requested to submit their audited statements by 30th September 2020 to Dr. Uttam Bhunia without fail.

2.3 **Status of Vol.45 of IJC:** Dr.T.S.Datta, Dr.R.G.Sharma & Dr. Soumen Kar updated the status of IJC Vol.45. It was informed that the said volume will be published by October 2020.

2.4 **UGC recognition:** There was a detailed discussion and brain storming on the subject of UGC recognition of IJC and how to take the journal to the next level. Despite lot of efforts and follow up from Dr. Datta, Dr. Sharma and Dr. Kar there has not been much response from UGC. Professor Atrey volunteered to meet Mr. Patwardhan –UGC CARE at the Head Office of UGC-CARE in Savitribai Phule Pune University, Pune, along with additional certificates of recommendations from reputed institutes like IIT, ISRO, and DAE.

2.5 Professor Atrey thanked Dr. Sharma for his contributions in last 10 years for single handedly taking the IJC to new heights with his meticulous dedication and diligence. There was a huge round of applause for Dr. Sharma.

2.6 **IJC new committee formation**: Honouring Dr. R G Sharma's desire to relinquish himself from the post of the Chief Editor of IJC, he was requested to join the advisory board. Professor Atrey proposed the name of Dr. Datta for this post. He was unanimously elected the new Chief Editor of IJC with immediate effect. Dr. Datta accepted his new post. The

members recommended Dr. Sharma and Dr. Upendra Prasad (IPR) to become the Advisory Board members of Superconductivity & Low Temp.Physics group of the journal, while Dr.V.Narayanan and Professor S.L.Bapat were recommended for the advisory board of Cryogenic engineering. (List attached).

2.7 **IJC Advisory Board structure:** Further there was a discussion on the matter of what should be the structure of the IJC board. There were suggestions of formation of a structure of Chief Editor, Associate Editor and the Editorial Board. Professor Atrey suggested that the new Editorial Board may collate all suggestions (given below) and develop further course of action. He further requested the Editorial Board to suggest strategies/solutions for the matter related to the UGC approval of IJC and present the same in the next EC meeting, to be held in December 2020.

2.8 Several suggestions, as below, were put forward regarding the IJC:

- a. IJC needs more papers and participation from the Industry
- b. Importance of impact factor of the journal
- c. Suggestion for symposium on low temperature Physics & Superconductivity
- d. Incentives/motivation for publication in IJC
- e. Increase participation of ISRO personnel for publication in IJC

2.9 **NSCS28:** February 2021 was ruled out for the conduct of NSCS28, due to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic. It will be tentatively held in November 2021 end or by the 2nd week of December 2021. Dr. Datta to confirm the dates. There was a suggestion that organizing virtual conference may be a possible route to shorten the long time gap. Professor Atrey suggested the organization of short virtual workshops/webinars of half a day or a day each on specific/general topics like low temperature Physics and industry etc. Dr. Kar pointed out that IJC volume cannot be published in the year 2021 if NSCS is delayed. In view of this, it was decided that papers of the virtual workshop may be published in IJC vol 46.

2.10 **Webinars:** Professor Atrey requested Mr. Parag Kulkarni to take the lead to organize the webinars. In addition, Mr. Kulkarni also volunteered to take responsibility for coming out with a reference book listing all the Indian industries involved in cryogenics with a possible "Buyers guide". A committee to be formed under his chairmanship. The committee will have at least one representative from each zone.

2.11 **Pending land issue:** There was a discussion between Dr. Sarkar and Dr. Datta on the land issue that has been pending, Dr. Datta felt it was important to keep the new EC members updated on the same. Dr. Sarkar apprised that as there are issues of funds, once normalcy in the situation of COVID-19 is restored, he will update on the status. It should take 6 months tentatively.

2.12 Professor Sarangi reiterated that the ICC community is too small to make an impact and suggested the creation of a small task force in order to persuade more people to join the community, to contact industries and to persuade DST/CSIR kind of funding agencies for participation.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair. The next EC meeting to be held in December 2020.
